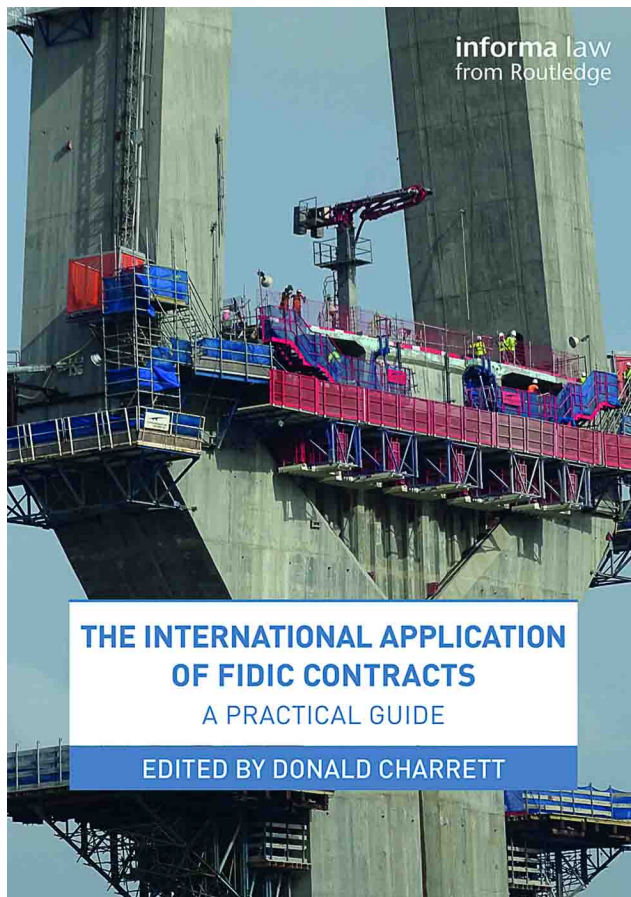


THE INTERNATIONAL APPLICATION OF FIDIC CONTRACTS – A PRACTICAL GUIDE
