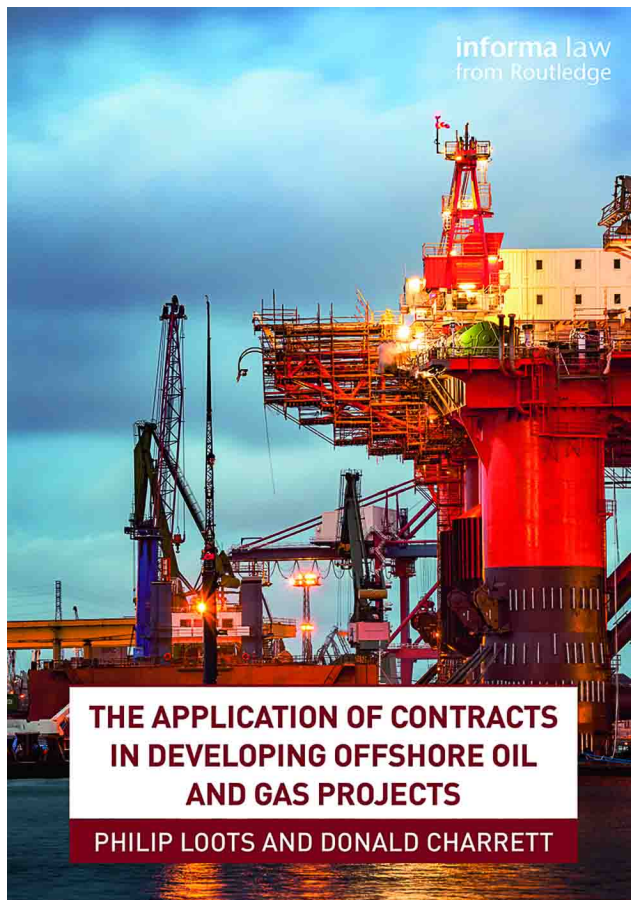


THE APPLICATION OF CONTRACTS IN DEVELOPING OFFSHORE
