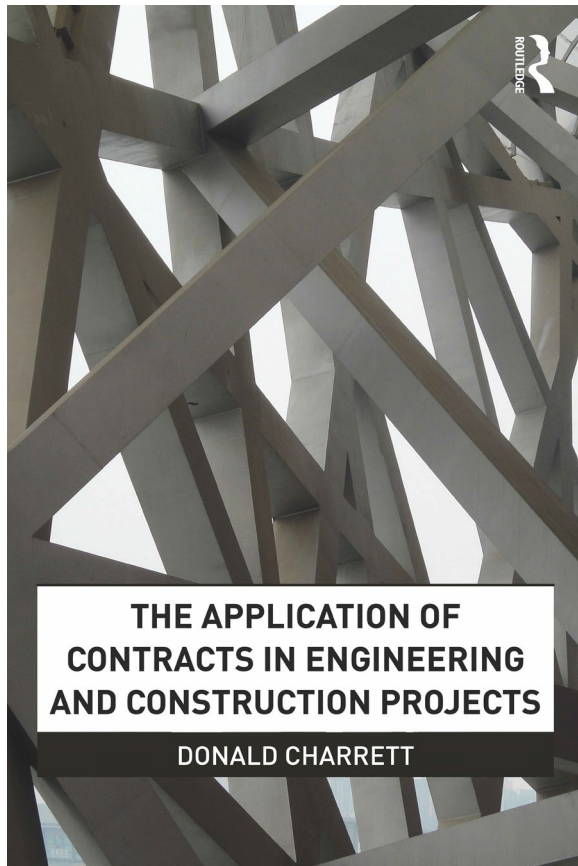


THE APPLICATION OF CONTRACTS IN ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS
