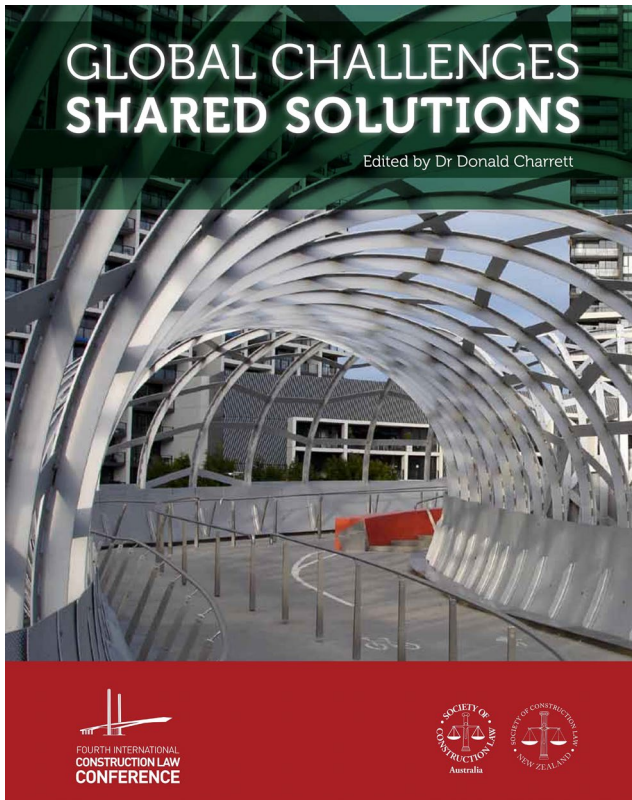


# GLOBAL CHALLENGES, SHARED SOLUTIONS
